

St. Mary's is now over 100 years old and we felt it was time to take a look at the building to make sure it will still be in good condition 100 years from now.

In mid-September a contractor was hired to repair 12 piers. He has identified a few more that should be repaired in the near future. A heavier gauge lattice has been installed eliminating the need for wire to keep out the golf balls.

We have had a very generous donation, from two Fenwick residents to re-shingle the roof on the west side, with stronger shingles. At the same time, we are hoping to re-shingle the damaged walls on the west side.

Our stained glass window has been evaluated and has been found to be in good condition. However, we have had some leaking through the caning. Since that part of the building is now level we are having an expert in stained glass windows reseal the window from the exterior and install permanent plastic protection.

Our future plans involve repairing or replacing the Connecticut flag; bringing in an expert to evaluate the condition of our interior wood; painting the exterior; and planting new bushes to help protect the west side from golf balls.

Thanks to many strong supporters of St. Mary's, especially at the time of the chapel's 100th birthday in 1987, we have a small reserve. We feel this money should be left intact. At this time we are asking for donations from the community to accomplish these projects. St. Mary's is a focal point of Fenwick whether one attends services or not.

St. Mary's is a building rich with history. In the spring we hope to have a speaker talk to us about the historical and architectural significance of the chapel.

## Church atmosphere belies borough's reputation for aloofness

OLD SAYBROOK — Privacy and constancy are watchwords in the posh borough of Fenwick, where residents play golf and tennis and swim off the sloping shores as they have since their blue-blooded ancestors founded the summer colony more than a century ago.

But at church, the sanctity of tradition and the legendary aloofness of Fenwickians both disappear.

At St. Mary's-by-the-Sea, an unassuming chapel west of the first green of the Fenwick Golf course, guest preachers take turns on the pulpit each week. A welcoming warmth emanates from the pews, they said.

"There's a wonderful sense of

family there," said Joshua L. Crowell, pastor at the First Congregational Church in Essex, who has led a summer service for at least the past 10 years.

"It's sort of like an adjunct of my congregation," he said. "I feel at home there."

Crowell is "a real favorite of people in the borough," said Sallie P. Boody, one of three chapel trustees with her sister, Julie Parsons, and her cousin, Ethel Davis.

St. Mary's opened in the 1880s after worshipers outgrew a local family's living room, where they had congregated because the horse and carriage trip to Old Saybrook's churches was too far.

The homey chapel on Agawan Avenue is as much a part of Boody's

heritage as summers on the scenic peninsula.

Her grandfather, J.H.K. Davis, known as "the Pope of Fenwick," first started inviting guest preachers. Boody's mother, Martha Soper, inherited the job, then passed it on to her daughters, who invite ministers of various denominations to lead the prayers.

As children, Boody and Parsons were responsible for posting a sign out front just before Sunday services, advising golfers to steer clear of the chapel for the duration of the 40-minute service. Over the years, the building has taken its hits; scuff marks dot the sides and roof, and Boody's husband, Robert, sometimes has to play the organ extra loud to drown out the balls.

"The golf balls striking the side, it's down home," said Crowell.

K. Dexter Cheney, pastor at All Saints' Episcopal Church in the Ivoryton section of Essex, who led his first service at St. Mary's last weekend, said the golf balls were "totally amusing" and part of an "absolutely delightful" morning in the borough.

Cheney said the 48 people who turned out for last Sunday's service were "very responsive ... relaxed and attentive." He said he was "very warmly received" by the Fenwickians, who have a reputation for standoffishness.

Peter B. Grandy, senior associate minister at the Asylum Hill Congregational Church in Hartford, also

finds the Fenwick congregation a welcoming one. Grandy knows many worshipers who attend his church in the winter and has become acquainted with others in his four years preaching at St. Mary's.

"They're very friendly. They appreciate you coming down," he said. "They make it very easy."

Services at St. Mary's are no different than services at any other area church — except for the Fenwick hymn written in 1944 and sung at the first and last service of each summer.

"There are few dry eyes when we sing it at the end of the summer," Boody said.

*Services at St. Mary's begin at 11 a.m. every Sunday except Aug. 14. The public is welcome.*






## Church Carvings Done By Lebanon Craftsman

LEBANON, July 6—It was one of those extremely hot, humid afternoons that we went to visit Gottlieb Laibradt on Village Hill Road. It's a pleasant farm home, with its rolling acres stretching in the rear as far as the eye could see.

For at one time Laibradt operated it as a dairy farm. But now his son John, with the latest in farm equipment carries on and Liebradt is taking a well-earned rest from what we found was a busy, eventful life.

Laibradt is the man who did all that marvelous interior wood-work for the restoration of Lebanon Congregational Church. He also designed and helped build the Lutheran Church of the Redeemer which is located across the road from his home and on the site of where the Village Hill School once stood.

### Born In Russia

Gottlieb Laibradt was born in the Ukraine (Little Russia) which has always been distinct from Great Russia, to the north. And it was in this country by the Black Sea that he started, at the age of 18, to learn the carpentry and woodworking trade. He came to the United States in 1915. At Cambridge, Mass., he found employment with a woodworking company that made store fixtures. He was paid 50 cents a day and out of this came board, and room and clothes. He worked for this very moderate wage, until finally they raised his pay to \$15 a week.

### Comes to Lebanon

In 1919, he left the Bay State and came to Lebanon where he brought a 100 - acre farm. He decided to be a dairy farmer and put away the tools of his trade, as he thought, forever.

Then came the hurricane that devastated Connecticut in 1938. Gottlieb was called upon to help with rebuilding. He built chimneys, houses and barns. Then he built the Lutheran Church that was dedicated in 1944.

Townsfolk who knew of Gottlieb's skill called on him to do the interior woodwork on the Lebanon Church which had been practically demolished by the hurricane until nothing was left intact but the facade. The church had been built originally in 1807 and was designed by the famous Revolutionary architect and painter, Col. John Trumbull, a student of Christopher Wren.

Restoration plans were provided by the late Frederick Kelly, of New Haven who won a great name for his restoration and design of Colonial buildings. With bits of moldings that were recovered from the wreckage of the church, Gottlieb started work. He set up his machines

in the church and for four years he toiled, with many discouraging moments when there was so little to follow in the way of Colonial design. The egg and dot cornice is a very important feature of the interior design. He made, by hand, 8,000 diamond designs for around the windows.


Following the dedication ceremonies at the church in 1950, Gottlieb again hung up his tools and prepared to spend a quiet slippered life by the fireside. But they just wouldn't let the skilled hands stay idle. From Fishers Island came a man who operated amusement rides. It seems some of the wooden animals needed restoring. So he went to work again carving, with the peculiar long keen knives that he has equipped with long slender curving handles.

By the way, we found he made the knives' keen blades himself, using files, because the steel in files is usually so good. He used ash for the handles, and a bit of copper tubing to join the blade with the handle.


When we arrived at his house, he was enjoying a TV program. He took us to his shop, where tools hang in orderly array.

He fingered them with loving care. But, with a sad smile he turned away.

"No more will I use them." We wonder.
